

# Accommodation Description

## Nova Apartment: FU37

The following is a description of your accommodation in Japan. We hope it will be comfortable and convenient for life in Japan. Accommodation does vary from what many people may be used to in their home country, but is still modern and comfortable. Due to space limitations and general building styles in Japan, the average room size in apartments is relatively smaller than in western countries. Room size is typically measured in *tatami*, traditional Japanese mats, approximately 3 x 6 feet. Many interior doors are *fusuma*, thin Japanese style wooden sliding doors.

In keeping with traditional Japanese interiors, your accommodation will be simply furnished. Common areas of the apartment are furnished for your convenience, including a refrigerator, washing machine, stove top (usually no oven), toaster, kitchenware, table, chairs, TV, VCR, vacuum, iron and curtains. Cleaning of the common areas and bedrooms is the responsibility of each tenant.

Bedrooms are ready to be setup by new tenants, with bedding, storage and hanging space provided as well as space for your own personal possessions. Bedding consists of a futon set (under mattress, top cover, and pillow), new sheets and a pillowcase.

Telephone landlines, internet connections (cable, DSL, fiber optic, wireless) and cable or satellite TV services are available in most parts of Japan, however services and suppliers do vary between areas. You may apply directly to your local provider for these services and obtain approval from the Accommodation Section. More information on these services will be provided in your orientation program.

Your accommodation is within walking distance of transport services and within a reasonable distance of your workplace, maps to which will be provided on your arrival in Japan.
